### **BACKGROUND**

The African Peer Review Mechanism (APRM) has received financing from the African Development Bank (AfDB) toward the cost of the APRM Institutional Support Project and intends to apply part of the agreed amount for this grant as payment towards the procurement of an experienced **Individual International Consultant** to conduct a **Targeted Review on the theme, “Universal Health Coverage under the Big 4 Agenda in the Republic of Kenya”**.

### **OBJECTIVES**

The objective of the Targeted Review is to identify the key issues of the Healthcare sector through the dissection of each of the key sub-sectors that it constitutes as a way for providing an overview of the state of the Healthcare sector with its opportunities and challenges in Kenya. In other words, the Targeted Review Report will bring out government’s efforts to manage any issue or challenges in the sector, the policies and strategies put in place and then give recommendations for improvement of the Healthcare sector in the best interest of the economy and people of Kenya.

The Consultant shall follow and also be guided by the specific objectives contained within the Socioeconomic Development (SED), Economic Governance and Management (EGM), Corporate Governance (CG), and Democracy and Political Governance (DPG) below.

The duration of the assignment is estimated at thirty (30) days including field days, starting in October 2021. In consultation with relevant staff at the APRM Continental Secretariat, APRM National Secretariat and other stakeholders, the consultant shall prepare and submit the following on the 14<sup>th</sup> day from the date of the contract:

- Prepare the Structure/Framework of the Report, the Power Point presentation, and the Key Highlights Paper on the theme “Universal Health Coverage under the Big 4 Agenda in the Republic of Kenya” and submit them on the 14th day from the date of the contract.

- Prepare and submit a Zero-Draft Report, a Power Point presentation and the Key Highlights Paper on the 28th day from the date of the contract.
- Prepare and submit the First Draft Report, a Power Point presentation, and the Key Highlights Paper on the last day of the field mission.
- Prepare and submit the Second Draft Report, a PowerPoint presentation, and the Key Highlights Paper on the 14<sup>th</sup> day from the completion of the field missions.
